

Title: Field Clinical Engineer- East Coast

Description Summary

Magnus Medical's Field Clinical Engineer (FCE) will have primary responsibility for providing training as well as remote and on-site technical support for sites running clinical trials sponsored by or collaborating with Magnus Medical. The FCE will provide training in the delivery of Stanford Accelerated Neuromodulation Therapy (SAINT), a novel rapid-acting non-invasive brain stimulation technique. The FCE will be based on the East Coast and report to the Senior Manager of Clinical Trials.

Roles and Responsibilities

- Support Clinical Affairs and Commercialization teams in the development of training programs for the SAINT Neuromodulation System
- Provide technical expert guidance and clinical trial site staff on-site training
- Provide troubleshooting support on-site or remotely for clinical trial sites
- Test Magnus Neuromodulation System software and provide feedback to the software team to assist ongoing internal software development
- Support the clinical affairs team with documentation and ongoing maintenance of documentation as it relates to training and/or device accountability
- Analyze and evaluate product malfunctions and complete complaint reports as required
- Assist with implementation of best practices at magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) centers to ensure good quality scans are obtained

- TMS technician experience is required. Experience with MagVenture equipment preferred
- Experience with neuronavigation equipment, particularly Localite software would be highly desirable
- Previous experience working in clinical trials or human subject research is preferred
